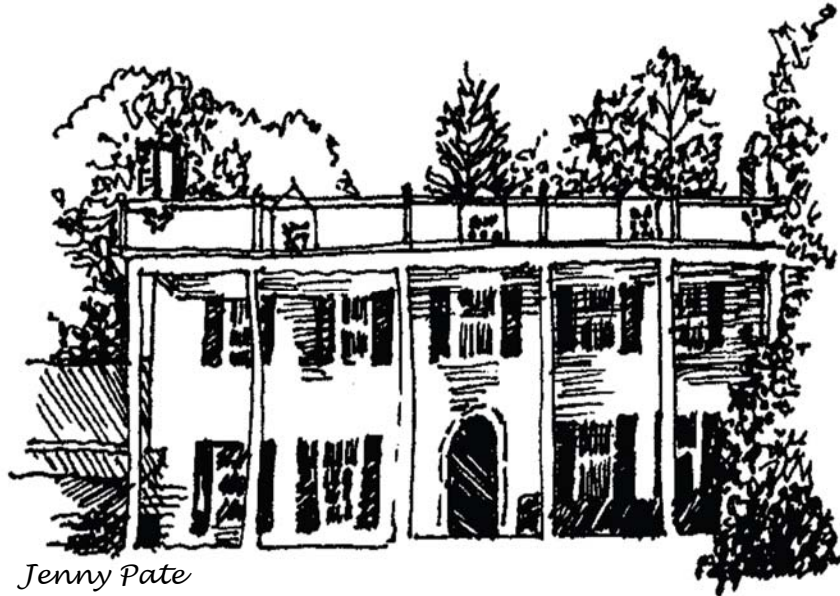


Oak Hill Open House

Celebrate local history at this free open house at
one of the oldest homes in Fairfax County!

4716 Wakefield Chapel Road, Annandale*

(Intersection of Wakefield Chapel Road and Braeburn Drive)

Historic Oak Hill is a privately owned 18th-century Georgian-style mansion, and is all that remains of the Ravensworth Tract – totaling more than 22,000 acres – dating from the 1670s.

This year's open house celebrates the 275th Anniversary of Fairfax County. **Brief ceremonies will take place from 12:30 to 1 p.m.** Before and after the ceremonies, walk through the first floor of the house and visit the Exhibitors Tent to get info from a host of local and historic organizations. Free refreshments will be provided by the Annandale High School Culinary Arts Program.
